#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We celebrate today the great Feast of Pentecost. Along with Easter and Christmas, Pentecost is one of the three most important days in the Church year. The Holy Spirit has come to give us the help that we need in life and to make us a holy Church. We welcome the Spirit and ask for ever-stronger gifts. Pentecost marks the end of the Easter season. We will remove the Easter

candle from the sanctuary as we return to Ordinary Time.

Our 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation Mass will be this Tuesday evening, May 21, at 7:00 p.m. For those who attend our evening Masses—please note that we will not have our usual 6:30 p.m. Mass on Tuesday. Everyone is welcome to the graduation Mass at 7:00 p.m. The last day of school will be Wednesday, May 22.

College Crew is a weekly event for college-aged young adults, offered at St. Charles this summer. We will begin on Monday evening, May 20, at 7:15 P.M. at the Youth House. This is a chance to take a good look at the faith, to have some interesting conversation, and to meet other young Catholics who are also serious about exploring their faith.

Next weekend, Fr. Frank lacona will join us at all of our weekend Masses, representing Cross Catholic Outreach. You may remember that we had a priest from this group three or four years ago. Cross Catholic Outreach helps people living in poverty in many countries around the world. Fr. lacona will bring pledge cards for those who would like to help with a gift.

Our parish seminarians have exciting plans this summer. Sam Martinez is on his way to Guatamala to live with a family and study Spanish for eight weeks. Noah Isch is going to a program in Texas to study Spanish. We have a lot of Spanish-speaking Catholics in our diocese and the bishop would like to have a diocese full of priests able to speak the language.

With abundant priests being transferred in June, we are blessed that Fr. Bobby was spared and we will be able to keep him at St. Charles for at least another year. He will be leaving next Saturday for a week of vacation, but he will return.

Iacona who will speak at all the Masses on behalf of *Cross Catholic Outreach* which was founded to create a meaningful link between parishes in America and the Priests and Nuns working in the Church overseas in the Caribbean, Africa, Asia, Central and South America. April continued to be busy for us helping the needy in our community. During the month we were able to help 104 individuals consisting of 68 adults and 36 children. We provided \$2,906 in rent and motel stays, \$2,578 in utility payments, \$305 in cards for gas and food, \$700 for furniture and household items and \$266 for food which provided 1400 pounds of food, \$410 for miscellaneous items. In addition, we give \$200 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish to help immigrant families. We spent a total of \$7,365 to help the needy.

We look forward to welcoming the new members that signed up during our membership drive.

Only through your generosity have we been able to help so many.

We are very grateful for your continued support. Thank you.



## Fr. Frank lacona

Fr. Frank Iacona was born in the hills of Montelepre, Sicily, near Palermo, but his family left for a better life; first to Canada then to the U.S. He grew up in Detroit where he began his professional career as a teacher, lawyer, and CPA. His career path led to the "good life", but he hungered for more, which led him to the inner city of Indianapolis working with the poor, seniors, and widows. Fr. Iacona was ordained on January 4, 2002, and is a priest in the Diocese of St. George's-in-Grenada. As an itinerant preacher, he strives to raise funds for the poor and to awaken the Christ in those in the pews. His guide and spiritual quest: Peace and joy, by affirming and giving thanks for the blessings in each of us. As it is said, "No God, no peace. Know God, know peace. To know God, look for the good in you and others."


encourage more vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. The Vocation Cross would need to be returned to the Sacristy before the following weekends Masses.


