A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We finish our school year this week, with students dismissed at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday. Our 8th grade graduation will take place Tuesday evening. It has been a good year and we are grateful for the dedication of our school families and especially for the

devotion of our faculty and staff. I think we can be proud of our parish school. Anyone who joins us for a school Mass will surely agree. Please note that the 7:00 p.m. Graduation Mass on Tuesday will take the place of our usual 6:30 p.m. Mass. All are welcome.

Many thanks to all who pledged for the Redeemer Radio Spring Sharathon. Our parish raised \$8,100 and the overall Sharathon total was \$267,365.

I'll be travelling to the Holy Land on October 2-12 with a pilgrimage organized by Redeemer Radio. We will visit the most important places where Christ walked, with Masses scheduled at the site of the Annunciation, the cave in Bethlehem, the Garden of Gethsemane, and the Church of the Holy Sepulcher at Calvary. The pilgrimage has a capacity of 50 people, and when I checked last week, 33 spots have been filled. For those who might be interested in taking part, I would suggest that you don't delay too long. Deacon Jake Schneider is now home, a new graduate of Mount St. Mary Seminary. His priestly ordination is just two weeks away. Please keep him in prayer.

He has been with us for two years and he will certainly be missed. We have no word on another priest being assigned to St. Charles, but with the upcoming ordination of seven new priests, we have high hopes that one will be sent to us. Fr. James and I are getting pretty old to cover all of the Masses and confessions in a busy parish. Another young priest would be a blessing!
