A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR


This weekend we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost. This feast marks the beginning of the Church and this feast reminds us of God the Holy Spirit, who offers us all the gifts we need to live as faithful and devoted followers of Christ. Pentecost is the last day of the Easter season, and Masses end with our Easter Alleluias and carrying the Easter candle out of the sanctuary.

I encourage generosity with our Pentecost seminarian collection. While our parish bake sale is a phenomenally successful effort to provide spending money for seminarians, this collection is the major effort to pay tuition, room and board. This past school year the diocese paid tuition for 25 seminarians in theology school and partial tuition for four undergraduate seminarians. Anyone with an idea of college tuition these days can guess how much this adds up to. It is an investment in the future of the Church.

On Tuesday we will have a Graduation Mass for the 8th grade class of our parish school. The Graduation Mass will be at 7:00 p.m. Please note: **we will not have a 6:30 p.m. Mass on Tuesday**. Of course, everyone is welcome to come to the 7 p.m. Graduation Mass.

Thursday is the final day of our St. Charles school year, with a 1:00 p.m. dismissal. This has been a most unusual year. In August, people were debating whether or not schools should open. Parents were debating whether or not to send their children. Our school staff and faculty were scrambling to come up with plans for remote learning, masks, sanitizing, spacing, and quarantines. Now, at the end of the school year, I have to say that our faculty, our staff, our parents, and our students have done an outstanding job of making this a successful school year. During the course of the year, we have had a few teachers and a number of students sick for a time with the virus and we have had many students in and out on quarantine. Yet, we have avoided major outbreaks and the school kept going. We have also found that we have a resilient school. Our students are able to learn, laugh, pray, and have fun together even with masks, spacing, and lots of sanitizing. We are grateful for all of the work and the positive attitudes that helped us complete a good school year. Look at our students and you will see happy children smiling under those masks.

We had a May discernment meeting of our Parish Council, cycling in four new members. 
It's almost time! Hope you all know what you are going to wear and who you are sitting with and are ready for some fellowship with our church family!


The St. Vincent dePaul Society is in need of drivers for their "carevan". This ministry involves transporting clients to and from medical appointments in our wheelchair-accessible van.


