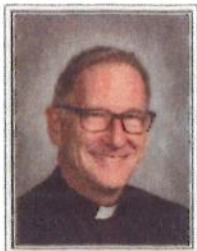

### MEMORIAL DAY PRAYER

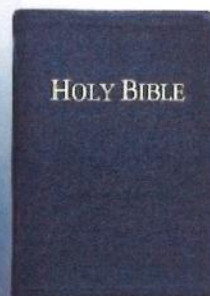

SVdP St Charles spent \$ 6,357.00 to help the needy in the community.
