



God of power and mercy, you destroy war and put down earthly pride. Banish violence from our midst and wipe away our tears, that we may all deserve to be called your sons and



## SIGN UP NOW TO TAKE HOME THE ST. CHARLES VOCATION CROSS Months of MAY & JUNE


Sign-up book is located in the Gathering Space.

SVdP St Charles spent \$ 6,357.00 to help the needy in the community.




