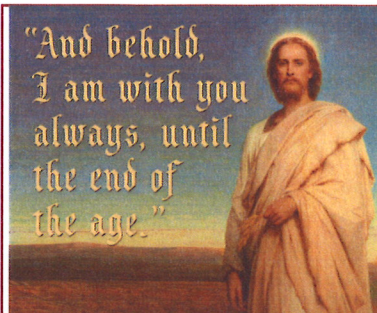

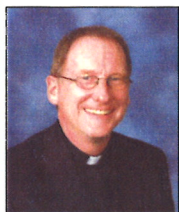

**A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR**

This weekend is Trinity Sunday. We stop to ponder our God: a God of mystery, a God of three Persons united in love. Next weekend, we celebrate Corpus Christi, the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. If the weather cooperates, we will carry out our annual Corpus Christi procession at the end of the 11:00 a.m. Mass. We will carry the Blessed Sacrament in procession around our parish property, expressing our faith and providing a public witness to that faith.

There will be an historic event in our diocese on Saturday. Seven young men will be ordained priests. It has been generations since we have had such numbers. This is truly an answer to prayers. The ordination will be restricted to those with invitations, but will be available by livestream on the diocesan website, diocesefwsb.org.

Last week, the Bishop determined that masks are now optional in church. He cites the drop in the infection rate and the morbidity rate from the virus. He also points out that adults who choose to be vaccinated have had that opportunity, and that the virus rarely has serious effects among children. Of course, masks are welcome for those who choose to wear them, and we need to be respectful of those who are at-risk and those who are afraid of the virus.

In addition, the Bishop has determined that the dispensation from our Sunday Mass obligation will end on June 11. We have a serious obligation to attend Mass on Saturday evening or Sunday, and that obligation will be formalized again. The obligation does not bind those who are ill or quarantined, those who are homebound or incapacitated by age, those who are at high risk of contracting the virus, and caretakers who can't leave someone alone.

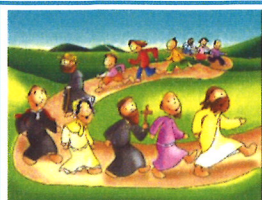
