

#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend is the Feast of Corpus Christi. We remember the great gift given to us in the Eucharist. Jesus is here in our midst. He feeds us, shows himself to us, and is present in the tabernacle. We come here to church to be in the presence of Jesus. Assuming that the weather is OK, we will have a Eucharistic procession at the end of the 11:00 a.m. Mass. As we plan

renovations to our church, the main driving factor is the desire to have the tabernacle visible and accessible in the church. Our new plans will expose the tabernacle in both chapel and church.

As we announced last weekend, we are bringing back the Sign of Peace during Mass. Out of respect for those who are susceptible to the virus, we ask for a non-contact sign of peace. Please wave, bow, wink or nod at your neighbors. With family members, you may kiss or hug or shake as you like.

The *Gifted and Sent Ministries* will be here on Sunday evening this weekend at 7:00 p.m. for an evening of praise music, with confessions offered in the Gathering Space. Come join some very talented musicians and sing the Lord's praise.

Our summer seminarian, LeeAllen Fortin, will be offering an evening scripture course this summer, focusing on the Old Testament prophets. Classes will be held in the Community Room (the choir room on the south side of the church Gathering Space) at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday evenings, beginning this week, June 8. Come for any or all of the sessions, bring your Bible, and learn a bit about the Old Testament. LeeAllen has just one year remaining in his seminary studies.

Our whole diocese is celebrating the ordination which is taking place this weekend on Saturday morning. Seven young men are to be ordained priests for our diocese. This is an answer to prayer and a sign of the vitality of our Church. We continue our St. Charles Prayer for Vocations.

For the past year, our organized parish **Ushers** have been replaced by **Monitors** (also known as the Welcoming Committee). They have been greeting people at the doors, distributing masks, helping with various jobs, and sanitizing the church after Masses. Now that we are winding down with our pandemic regulations and no longer need to do so much sanitizing, we are going to combine ranks with ushers and monitors and resume a monthly schedule. We will have an organizational meeting on Thursday evening, June 17, in the church at 7:00 p.m. All current and past ushers and monitors are invited, and we would also invite anyone else who might like to join in this ministry.

Someone recommended to me a short video found on Formed.org. I haven't been on that website recently, but found dozens of really good short videos, educational talks and movies. The parish subscribes and everyone can enter for free. Go to Formed.org and use our parish code, 600e3.

Finally, Fr. Thomas Zehr will be leaving us on June 14 to begin his new assignment at St. Mary's in Huntington. We will have a simple reception to thank him and wish him well next weekend, on June 13, after the 11:00 a.m. Mass. Join us in the Hession Center.




