

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

The Church celebrates Pentecost this weekend. The Holy Spirit is the very presence of God in our world, in our Church, and in each of our lives. We are poor, week, mortals who can't follow God's path perfectly, can't earn our way to heaven, and can't bring the faith to others on our own. We turn to the Holy

Spirit. Be with us. Change us and change our world.

This weekend is the time for the Annual Diocesan Pentecost Collection. This is the collection used to pay tuition costs for our seminarians. A gift to this collection is an investment in the future of the Church. If you aren't prepared for the collection today, write a check in the next week or two and write "Pentecost Collection" in the memo line.



Please join us for a reception in the Hession Center after the 11:00 a.m. Mass next Sunday, June 15. Fr. Jery, another priest from the same monastery, is due to arrive on Tuesday of this week. We offer him a warm welcome.


