



A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend is Corpus Christi Sunday, a time when we focus especially on the great gift we are given in the Eucharist-the gift of Christ himself. During our three-year Eucharistic Revival period, we are especially intent on sharing with the world our faith in the Eucharist. Our Corpus Christi procession will

take place at the end of the 11:00 a.m. Mass, with children in their First Communion clothes tossing flower petals in the procession. Even if you came to an earlier Mass, you are welcome to return and join us in the procession or to drive by.

As we announced the sad news of Fr. Koehl's transfer to North Manchester, we now have happy news to follow. One of our brand-new priests, Fr. Bobby Krisch, will be his replacement here at St. Charles. Many will remember Fr. Bobby from his time here as a summer seminarian the summer of 2018. Fr. Bobby is from St. Jude Parish in South Bend, where he celebrated his first Mass last weekend. Fr. Bobby was a delayed vocation, working for a time as a C.P.A. before he went to seminary. He will begin his assignment here on June 21. We will be blessed to have him.

We will have a reception next Sunday. June 18, after the 11:00 a.m. Mass to thank Fr. Koehl for his two years of dedicated service at St. Charles and to wish him well as he begins his new role as a pastor. Join us for a simple reception next weekend.

As we are still living the excitement of last week's ordination. we offer our congratulations to Fr. Jake Schneider. Fr. Jake has been a St. Charles parishioner his entire life and celebrated his first Mass here last weekend. He will now be assigned to St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, on the southwest side of town.

Each Sunday a family, couple, or individual will come forward during the Parish Vocation Prayer to receive the "Vocation Cross and A Special Book of Vocation Prayers" written for each day of the week. In taking the cross, they commit themselves to pray during the week to encourage more vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. The Vocation Cross would need to be returned to the Sacristy before the following weekend's Masses.

EUCHARISTIC SAINT FOR JUNE: ST. THOMAS MORE



St. Thomas More (1478-1535) was Eucharistic born in London. With a reputation for being honest and effective, he served King Henry VIII, rising to become Lord Chancellor in 1529.

Thomas was ultimately beheaded by the King for his fidelity to the Catholic faith. Of the Eucharist, he said, "Now, when we have received Our Lord. let us not then leave Him alone as we get involved in other things. Instead, let all our concern be focused on Him. Let us by devout prayer and meditation talk with Him. Let us say with the prophet: 'I will hear what our Lord will speak within me.' If we set aside all other things and attend to Him. He will inspire us and grant us great spiritual comfort and profit. Having received the Blessed Sacrament, we have a special time of prayer. Let us not allow this occasion to slip by. St. Thomas More's feast day is June 22. Learn more about his Eucharistic devotion at diocesefwsb.org/eucharist.




PINK ENVELOPES FOR VOTIVE CANDLES


