#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!


It is good to be back in our church! One parishioner told me, "I'd still be at St. Charles if we were doing Mass in a cave." However, no one would choose a cave or a gym for the long term. We are back in our sacred space. We have kneelers, we have hymn books, we have a pipe organ and a real piano, and we have our

tabernacle front and center. This is where we come to find God and I think we are all grateful to be home.

I offer thanks to those who have made this renovation project possible. We are grateful for Bill Heyer, our architect. We are grateful for Gwyneth Thompson-Briggs, who painted the paintings, and for Albl Studio, where our crucifix was carved. We are grateful for the many construction workers who made this happen: Schenkel Construction, F&M Tile and Terrazzo, LA Electric, Last Pew Sound, the Italian Marble Company, T&T Plumbing, and the Reuter Organ Company. I offer thanks, too, to our renovation committee: Margaret Ryan, Kelly Tippmann, Cece Dunderman, Melissa Thompson, Darlene Simpson, Bob Current and Keith Heimann. I am especially grateful for all of the parish volunteers who removed upholstery staples, worked on carpentry, moved furnishings, cleaned dust, sewed altar cloths, carried organ pipes, painted Stations, and moved chairs and equipment in and out of the gym, and did a hundred other tasks. A lot of parish labor went into this project. Finally, I am grateful to all of our donors who made this possible. I pray that the project will give glory to God and will help us to be more focused in our prayer.

A word to parents with little children: we treasure the children in the parish and we want to encourage you in every way as you bring them to Mass. For times when it is needed, we now have an updated cry room with speakers and a volume control on the wall. We also have speakers and volume control dials in the Gathering Space. If your child is having a bad day and there is a need to disappear for a few minutes, it should be easy to duck away in either space and return when the storm has passed.


I offer a reminder also of our new hearing loop system. For those with hearing aids, if you have a T-coil, push the button and you will be piped in directly to our sound system. I had two parishioners tell me that they didn't have a T-coil in their hearing aids, but they found that their provider could easily add it.






