

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR




As we bid farewell to Fr. Thomas, we are now welcoming Fr. Dan Koehl as our new associate at St. Charles. Fr. Dan is planning to move in on Monday and make his home at St. Charles. Unfortunately, I don't think that there will be a chance to meet him next weekend; he will be joining our high schoolers on a youth conference in Steubenville. There will be plenty of opportunity after that.

The Borromeo Bash was a wonderful event this year. We owe thanks to the organizers, who never let a pandemic get in the way of their optimism. We had a good crowd, a great meal, some fine items for bidding, and most important, a chance to get together and have fun. This was much needed after a long year of isolation. We offer thanks to the organizers.

Our seminarian, LeeAllen, is continuing his class on the minor prophets in the Bible. There was a great response from the first session. Everyone is invited on Tuesday evenings at 7:00 p.m. in the Community Room. (Also known as the Choir Room, on the south side of the Gathering Space.) Bring a Bible.

Finally, we have good news for our church renovation plans. The Bishop and the Diocesan Art and Architecture Committee were excited about our plans and gave us a green light. Now the diocesan finance committee has also given us the OK. At this point we are scrambling to put all of the pieces together. We have contractors bidding for the construction and we are lining up the artisans to carve a crucifix, do the marble work for the altar, and do the paintings. Our plan is to have a capital campaign in the fall, combining it with the Annual Bishop's Appeal. We will close the church after Christmas, and our goal is to have the renovations done in time for Easter. (Construction this winter won't interrupt any wedding plans.) During the renovation, weekend Masses and school Masses will be held in the gym and the other daily Masses will be held in the Gathering Space. There are a hundred details to work out at this point. I will keep you informed.
