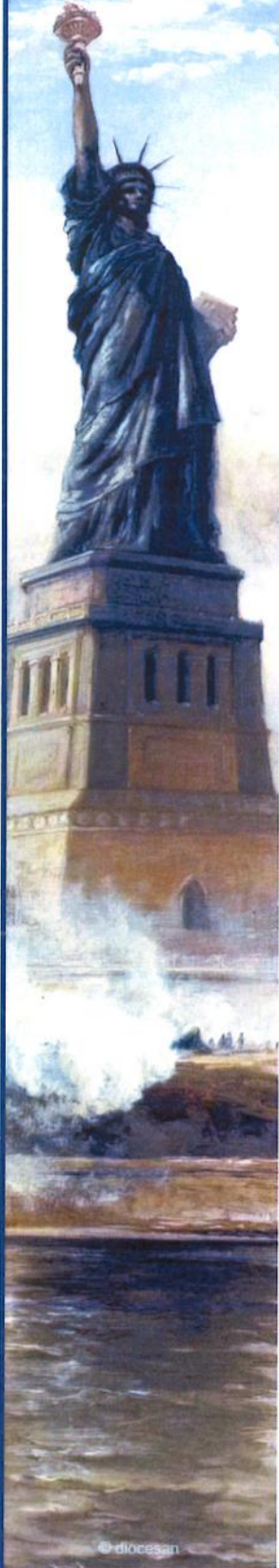

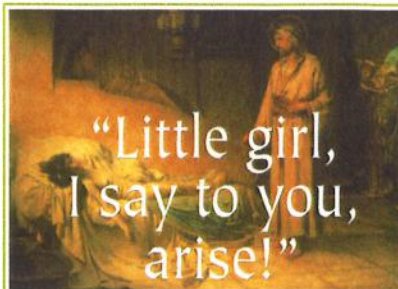

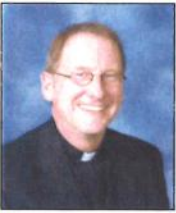

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



The Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis is fast approaching, July 17-21. We have a parishioner who bought two tickets at a discounted price and now is not able to attend. If you would be interested in the tickets, give us a call at the parish office, 482-2186.

Another word of thanks to our parish Knights of Columbus. This summer they have assembled our new gaga pits, they cut and hauled away the silver maple trees on the south side of the school, they have built beautiful shelving for the school, they are painting student desks, and they are cooking for Fr. Bobby's Thursday evening events. We are blessed to have such an active group in our parish!

On the topic of active parish groups, I have in front of me the report from our parish St. Vincent de Paul Society. In the past calendar year, they served 1823 people, distributing \$106,000 in funds as well as helping people in many other ways.

I haven't yet had a chance to attend one of Fr. Bobby's Bibles and Burgers nights, but I am hearing good reviews. There will be no gathering on the Fourth of July, but it will continue for the rest of the Thursdays in July.

Finally, the diocese is organizing an ongoing series of college-level theology courses for lay people who would like to dive into theology. The program will be called the *St. Cyril of Jerusalem Catechetical Institute*. It will take three years to complete all of the courses, but a person can jump in at any time. The first class will be offered at St. Francis University on ten Tuesday evenings, beginning Sept. 24. For more information, go to the diocesan website, diocesefwsb.org/cyiril.


