If that is a challenge, catch one of our volunteers after a weekend Mass to sign up. We would like to have everyone pictured in the new directory.

The end of June marks the halfway point of the year, six months into the year. For reasons beyond anyone to explain, our parish has been hit with a remarkable number of funerals this year. In the year 2022, we had 50 funerals in our parish. We are now six months into 2023 and we have already had 45. We also need to offer thanks to our hard-working funeral luncheon ladies, our funeral choir, our liturgists, Tim and Karen, and our livestream crew. They have all had a workout this year.


