A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

I continue with my reminders to sign up for a photo appointment for the parish picture directory. We are only three weeks away from those sessions. We would like to have everyone in this parish included in the book. To sign up for an appointment, use the QR code in this bulletin, go to our parish website and click on the orange

banner at the top of the home page, or catch a volunteer after a weekend Mass. Many families find that this is a great opportunity to buy professional family photos. If you don't want to purchase photos, it costs nothing to have a picture taken. You will be included in the directory, you will receive one free photo, and you will receive a directory when they are complete.

The picture directory will have some pages showing our parish life. If you have a good photo or two of a First Communion, Confirmation, a wedding or baptism, a social event, or something happening at St. Charles, pass it on to me. We might be able to use it. My e-mail address is fathertom@scbfw.org.

We are scheduled to have patches of asphalt removed and replaced on the parking lot on Monday and Tuesday, July 10 and 11. My understanding is that some of the work will be near the Gathering Space doors. For those coming to Mass on those days, it might require parking a little farther away or even using a different door. Priests will be here for Masses and confessions. Please be flexible and we'll make things work.

Finally, I point out several opportunities for young people who might be wondering about a religious vocation:

The diocese is organizing a "Come and See" day for any young men, ages 16-30, who might like to learn more about priestly vocations. It will be held in Warsaw on July 21 from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Registrations are needed by July 14 and information is available at diocesefwsb.org/discern.

The Capuchin Sisters of Nazareth are having a "Come and See" weekend on Oct. 13-15 for young women ages 15-25. They are located in Williamsport, Pennsylvania—a long but beautiful drive. Information is at www.capuchinsisters.com.

Closer to home, the Sisters of St. Francis of Perpetual Adoration (the sisters stationed at St. Francis University) are based in Mishawaka. 


