

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

Someone asked this week about the finances of our renovation. You will remember our "Welcoming the Tabernacle" campaign last fall; our goal was \$1.8 million, with \$225,000 dedicated to last year's Annual Bishop's Appeal. Our pledges went over the top. Even with the extras and overruns which invariably come with a

construction job, the funds from that campaign were enough to pay for the renovations. By far the biggest line item in the renovation was the terrazzo floor. [For anyone who kept an eye on the construction work, you will understand why. There were tons of materials needed and it was a labor-intensive job to mix, pour, smooth, grind, polish and seal the floors]. I think that the floor was a prudent investment. Not only is it beautiful, but it will last as long as the building lasts. Unlike carpet, we won't need to replace it every 20 years. We also saved a lot of money thanks to our volunteer labor. The construction company advised that we buy new pews, which would have cost somewhere between three hundred-and five hundred-thousand dollars. Instead, crews of parishioners put in long hours removing upholstery staples and working on pew repairs. These pews have served us for 47 years and I expect that they will last for generations to come.

For the last four years, in my spare time I've been building a chapel in the rectory. I brought back some wooden statues on a trip to South America and then decided to create a chapel in the house. Our rectory was built with a parlor, a room that was rarely used. It has now become a Spanish colonial-style chapel, and the chapel is nearly complete. After the furnishings were constructed, I installed a Mexican tile floor, decorative beams on the ceiling, and I cut into the wall to turn a plain rectangular door into a round-topped door. For those who would like to see it, we are going to offer an open house as part of Cardinal Fest on September 10. Watch for details.






