A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR




I am covering Sunday Mass at the oratory at Big Long Lake this weekend. With three priests in the parish, we are blessed to be able to offer help when neighboring priests are away on vacation or retreat. Fr. Bill Sullivan has moved into his retirement apartment in Ossian. It was a joy having him with us for a few weeks.

The Gifted and Sent team will return this Sunday evening, July 11, at 7:00 p.m., to lead us in prayer

and reflection on our faith. Their previous evenings have been wonderful; I encourage you to come if you are able. We will meet in the church at 7:00 p.m.

We will have a missionary speaking at Masses next weekend. Brother Henry Gaither represents the Brothers of the Sacred Heart, a group with missions in Kenya, Lesotho, Mozambique, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe, and the Philippines. You can find photos of some of their missionary activity on our parish Facebook page and also on our website in the "Coming Events" section. Please be as generous as you can. We will put an extra collection basket on the tables in the back of church and mark it clearly for the missions.

Renovation news: we have lined up woodcarvers Oberammergau, Germany to carve the corpus for our new crucifix, which will be suspended above the altar. If you would like to see some of their work, go to albl-oberammergau.com. The Albl family has been carving for churches since 1556. Our new corpus will be carved from linden wood, natural wood color, and four and a half feet tall. We are currently talking to the carvers about the style of carving. We will find some place of honor for our current crucifix, and it will be used for Good Friday veneration.

The Brothers, who staff schools and other establishments in over thirty countries, are asking for your prayers and financial assistance. 


