### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

We had troubles with our new sound system last weekend. Hopefully that will be resolved by the time you read this bulletin.

Trends in our parish: Our weekend Mass attendance has risen around 20% since we have left the gym and returned to the

church. We have dropped from our pre-pandemic numbers, but I am hopeful that when summer is over we will see many people return. What is exciting, though, is the number of people coming for confessions and daily Mass. We have two hours of confessions scheduled on Saturday afternoons. Before the pandemic, we had one priest for the first hour and two priests for the second. Now, we need two priests for the full two hours, and both priests are kept busy. Our daily Mass numbers have also risen. We have now officially moved the 6:30 p.m. daily Mass from the chapel into the church; the chapel was often overfilled. This is wonderful to see.

This Friday is the feast day of St. Mary Magdalene. For those who have never visited the new Oratory of St. Mary Magdalene, on Wallen Road across the street from St. Vincent, I encourage you to spend some time there. The Blessed Sacrament is exposed there for Adoration 24 hours a day. St. Jude also has a 24-hour Blessed Sacrament chapel. Both are recruiting people who are willing to commit to a consistent hour each week. I know that many St. Charles parishioners are on the schedule at St. Jude and I want to encourage that. This weekly hour is a beautiful gift to the Lord and a beautiful way to find peace in the presence of the Lord.

I am leaving Monday morning for vacation time with my brother and sister-in-law. I will return late on July 28<sup>th</sup>. You are in good hands with Fr. James and Fr. Koehl.




