A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR




We welcome this weekend Brother Henry Gaither who will talk about the work of the Brothers of the Sacred Heart, who minister in Africa and in the Philippines. This is our chance to help spread the Gospel in areas of great poverty and need Since we aren't passing collection baskets at this time, we will place an extra collection basket on the

tables at the church doors and mark them "Missionary Collection." You may make a check to the parish and write "missionary" in the memo line, or of course you may make a cash donation.

Next weekend, a speaker from St. Anne's Home will offer a few words at the end of Mass. St. Anne's Home is a facility owned by the diocese which offers Independent Living, Assisted Living, Nursing Care, Rehabilitation, and care for those with memory loss. They offer daily Mass for residents, and their chaplaincy staff includes a full-time Catholic priest and two religious sisters.
