Each Sunday a family, couple, or individual will come forward during the Parish Vocation Prayer to receive the *"Vocation Cross and A Special Book of Vocation Prayers"* written for each day of the week. In taking the cross, they commit themselves to pray during the week to encourage more



vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. The Vocation Cross would need to be returned to the Sacristy before the following weekends Masses.

We are like Martha. There is plenty to be anxious about, but only one thing is required of us. For five minutes today, be like Mary. Rest with Jesus; ask him what he requires of you. The *Saint Charles Indulgence Group* will host a public Rosary the first Sunday evening of every month after the 5:00 p.m. Mass as an act of gaining a plenary indulgence. You are welcome to join us in the Community Room just off the Gathering Space. You can pray for a loved one who has passed, or you can ask for the indulgence to be applied to yourself. The requirements include being in a state of grace and a sacramental confession 20 days before or after the act. The group is also looking for volunteers to pray for those souls whose names have been recorded in the Saint Charles Book of Remembrance. These names are added every November, so we are currently praying for those who passed in 2024. Join us August 3, after the 5:00 p.m. Sunday Mass and learn what indulgences can do for you.
