#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We welcome this weekend Tyler Kolden, representing the Mary, Mother of God Society. This missionary group works to help the Catholic parishes of Vladivostok and eastern Siberia, along the Pacific coast, north of Korea. This is an area where the Russian Orthodox Church

predominated and where for decades the Soviet Union taught atheism. It is good to know that the Catholic Church has a presence and that we have brothers and sisters living in a part of the world about as far from here as one can get. A second collection this weekend will go to the mission society. If you aren't prepared for the collection this weekend, you may mark an envelope or mark a check in the memo line and drop it in the collection basket in the next couple of weeks.

We offer prayers for our World Youth Day pilgrims who will leave on Friday. They are flying to Portugal to celebrate the Catholic faith along with Pope Francis and 600,000 other young Catholics. I believe that we have 20 parishioners making the trip: high schoolers, chaperones, and young adults. We are especially excited about the Englishspeaking Stations of the Cross, one of the World Youth Day events. Several young adults will give a brief story of their faith journey at that event. Caleb Perkins, a St. Charles member, was chosen to give one of those witness talks. Caleb and his wife, Natali, were committed Christians who took part in our parish RCIA and joined the Catholic Church in 2021. My understanding is that both of them will be standing on the stage very near Pope Francis as Caleb shares the story of his faith journey in a stadium full of people.

Our new parish picture directory will include the photos of all of those who opt to have their photos taken. It will also include names and addresses of all of our registered parishioners. It will not list telephone numbers nor e-mail addresses. If you are registered in the parish and you do not want your name and address included in the book, please contact me at fathertom@scbfw.org. I offer a reminder to those who procrastinate: Photography sessions begin next week. It only takes a minute to sign up for an appointment.

I will be away this week from Sunday evening until Friday afternoon. I'm going for retreat to Gethsemane Abbey in Kentucky. It is a Trappist monastery, where silence is the rule.

Finally, a bit of fun history: Our parish was founded in 1957. In all of these years we have had only three pastors, but 34 associates. I guess we are hard on our young priests!

Due to the pictures being taken in the nursery, the nursery will not be accessible during those weeks. We will have to close the nursery for Sunday, August 6 and 13 as well.




#### SIGN UP NOW TO TAKE HOME THE ST. CHARLES VOCATION CROSS Months of JULY & AUGUST


