

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

I am away on vacation, returning on Friday. You are in good hands with Fr. James and Fr. Koehl.

Next weekend, Sister Veronica Nugent will offer some words about vocations at the end of the Mass. Sr. Veronica is the daughter of St. Charles parishioners Jim and Madeline Nugent. Sister Veronica belongs to the Capuchin Sisters of

Nazareth, based in Pennsylvania. Our parish has been blessed in recent years with seminarians on the path to priesthood, but we haven't had many young women discern religious life. We welcome Sr. Veronica and we continue our Prayer for Vocations.

As we think of vocations, it may be good to be aware of the new Women's Discernment House here in Fort Wayne. In the past 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ years during the pandemic and construction, our parish ministries have been hit hard. 
