A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Today has been designated by Pope Francis World Day of Prayer for Grandparents and the Elderly. This is brand-new event in the Church. This is a time to remember the wisdom of the elderly, and to remember the sacrifices made for us by grandparents, teachers, and others who came before us. [A warning: cards


congratulation are surely fine for grandparents. However, it may be best to use caution in sending cards to the elderly. For those of us who may be sensitive about that label, prayers are a better option!]

Our summer seminarian, LeeAllen Fortin, will be leaving us this Friday. It has been a joy having him for the summer. His weekly Bible study has been very well researched and very well attended. He has been active in a lot of different aspects of our parish life and has touched many people. We have also received exciting news: he has received his Call to Orders and will soon be ordained a deacon. The Ordination Mass will take place at the Fort Wayne Cathedral at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 4. Everyone is invited to this event. If you have never attended an ordination, this is the one to choose; with only one candidate, there should be plenty of seating. After finishing his last year of seminary, his priesthood ordination is scheduled for June. When he leaves us, LeeAllen's address will be: Mount St. Mary's Seminary of the West, 6616 Beechmont Ave., Cincinnati, OH 45230.

If anyone missed the chance to contribute to the Sacred Heart Brothers and their missionary work, you may still make out a check to St. Charles and mark it so that we know it is for the missions. This is a chance to help those who live in utter poverty. We are a parish which understands that this is important. We received a note this week from Cross Catholic Outreach, thanking everyone for the great support they received when they sent a priest in May. "Because of you, children in Mozambique will be supplied school, food, and health care. Because of you, these children know that they are loved and not forgotten." A few dollars will go a long way in Africa. Thank you for your generosity.

Finally, you may remember a bulletin announcement four weeks ago in which I told of the new memorial on the Church calendar for Blessed Solanus Casey. Father Solanus was a Capuchin priest who served for ten years in Huntington and is now beatified and under consideration for canonization. On June 30, after the 6:15 Mass celebrating Blessed Solanus, our seminarian politely stated, "I thought his feast day was July 30." So it is. We'll do it again on Friday. This is the kind of mistake which the elderly sometimes make.


