

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

School opens on Wednesday with a full day of classes. Our enrollment numbers are looking very good and we are anxious to have students returning.

The Borromeo Bash held in June was a great success, not only providing some much

-needed socializing in the parish, but also providing some generous funds for church and school. We are about to replace a 22-year-old telephone system throughout the school, parish office, church, youth house and rectory. We are also planning a fall project to landscape the front of the church (the parking lot side) with flowers, trees and shrubs. We are grateful for the generous donors and all of the workers who made Borromeo Bash happen.

The parish has received an invitation from Anne Therese Stephens to the Mass of Solemn Consecration to a life of virginity. Anne Therese works for the diocesan Tribunal and has done a lot of young adult ministry in the diocese. Some words from the instructions in the consecration ritual: "The consecrated virgin is a particularly striking sign of the love of the Church, the Bride, for Christ, her Bridegroom. At the same time, the consecrated virgin is a faithful reminder of the life which is to be ours in the Kingdom of Heaven, life belonging completely to Christ." Unlike our religious sisters, a consecrated virgin does not use the title "Sister", does not wear a habit and does not live in community. Hers is a life dedicated in a singular way to the Lord. The Mass of Consecration will take place at the Fort Wayne Cathedral on Sunday, October 3, at 3:00 p.m.


