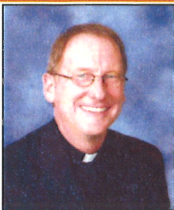

This Tuesday, August 15, is a **Holy Day of Obligation**, the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin. There will be a Vigil Mass at 6:30 p.m. on Monday. Masses on Tuesday are 6:15 a.m., 8:15 a.m., 12:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.

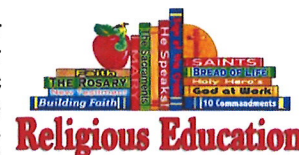
