A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

We thank everyone for supporting our annual Seminarian Bake Sale this weekend. The bake sale was initiated by Fr. Jacob Myer as a way to help seminarians with travel expenses and living expenses, and it has been a source of verywelcomed funds. St. Charles is the patron saint of seminarians, and I would say that we are

following his lead as we support the formation of these young men. Thank you to all who provided baked goods, all who purchase the baked goods or donate, and to the parish Vocation Committee for all of their efforts in organizing the event.

We welcome Bishop Rhoades for a school visit on Friday. He will preside at our 8:15 a.m. Mass and then spend time visiting in classrooms. Everyone is welcome to join us for the 8:15 a.m. Mass on Friday. We will have folding chairs as needed, expecting that the church could be filled. With our renovations, we reduced our seating capacity a bit, removing two pews to the right of the altar and one very short pew to the left. This will rarely be noticed. However, when both kindergarten and preschool join us at an all-school Mass we have over 800 students plus teachers and aids. This doesn't leave a lot of seating for the rest of the parish. Please don't be deterred. We will have some pews available and we will have chairs available on those occasions. An occasional overflowing church is a blessing and a sign of a healthy parish.

We are blessed to have three priests at St. Charles, allowing us on some weekends to help other parishes when priests are away. We covered parishes in LaGrange and Huntington the last two weekends and we have commitments in other parishes several weekends in September and October. We are happy to help and it is good to experience the liturgy in other parishes too. For those who are following Fr. Koehl's series of homilies about the Eucharist, they will still be available on the parish website when he is out of town.

Cardinal Fest is coming soon, September 9, 10 and 11. There will be a teen dance on the evening of the ninth. On September 10, we will have games, inflatable attractions, food trucks, bingo, and tours of the new rectory chapel during the afternoon and early evening. Later in the evening, a beer tent and cornhole for adults. Sunday, September 10, will be the Annual Monsignor John Suelzer 5K Run and Fun Walk. Rob Sordelet and I have again swallowed our pride and agreed to wage the pastor/principal contest in the 5K. I'm looking at photos of last year's finish and hoping that no one brings cameras this year.

Is there an APP for SCRIP?

Yes...can be used to purchase e-gift cards and add funds to your reloadable gift cards.

What are e-gift cards? They are digital gift cards that are delivered electronically and saved to your virtual wallet in minutes using the RaiseRight app or website. There are over



the RaiseRight app or website. There are over 400 brands available 24/7 and they can easily be used for online shopping or scanned by the retailer at check-out in store.

What is a reloadable gift card? It is a physical gift card initially purchased from St. Charles which can be electronically reloaded with funds using the RaiseRight app or website. Reloadable cards save time, reduce waste, and are great for regular purchases to your favorite stores. There are over 140 reloadable gift cards available.

<u>How do I start using the app?</u> Using the RaiseRight app requires a linked bank account and a special St. Charles code, so contact a <u>SCRIP</u> coordinator to get all the details.


