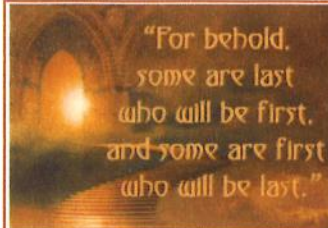

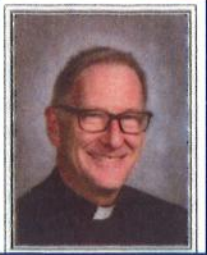

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We are taking up a collection throughout the diocese this weekend to help with the humanitarian crisis in Gaza. Half of the funds will be used by Catholic Relief Service and half by the Catholic Near East Welfare Organization, two groups which have a presence in Gaza and are doing their best to help with food and medical care. Checks can be made out to St. Charles with "Gaza" written in the memo line.

Our parish Religious Education Program is designed for children grades 1-8 who are not enrolled in a Catholic school. Monday evening classes begin at 6:30 on September 8. With Cardinal Fest coming on September 5 and 6, we will also be collecting in the Gathering Space two-liter bottles of pop, pre-packaged treats, fun-sized candy and gift cards for bingo prizes. We will make sure that the healthy foods go into the blue barrels while the pop, candy and cakes go to Cardinal Fest!

During **July 2025**, we were able to help 175 individuals consisting of 107 adults and 68 children. Summary of assistances provided to our Neighbors includes: \$ 17.00 bus passes, \$ 400 auto payment, \$ 871 auto repair, \$ 354 in food vouchers, providing 1,863 pounds of food, \$1,250 in gift cards, \$1,040 for motel stays, \$3,666 rent/mortgage, \$3,957 in utility payments, \$814 store vouchers, \$1,450 partnering with local Parishes, and \$200 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish. SVdP St Charles spent \$14,019 to help the needy in the community.
