


A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

I don't know numbers, but last weekend's bake sale attracted a lot of baked goods and a lot of shoppers. After a couple of years of pandemic bake sales without baked goods, it is good to see some return to normal. Thank you for your support. We especially thank our hard-working Vocation Committee.

As announced last week, we are really short on ministers for all kinds of duties at Mass. Sacristans come early to set up books and vessels before Mass and then put things away after Mass. Ushers greet people before Mass, take up the collection and help with Offertory Gifts, and then pass out bulletins after Mass. Lectors proclaim the Scriptures. Extraordinary Ministers help in serving Holy Communion. Cantors and choir members use their voices to lead us in prayer. If you might be able to help in one of these ministries, please let us know. 




