A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

I offer a huge thanks to all of the workers who made Cardinal Fest a reality. We had a great turnout for the teen dance on Friday evening and the biggest crowd I remember for our Saturday events. It was a fun event for the parish and we are indebted to those who put in so much work. The weather cooperated on Friday and Saturday,

with rain coming on Saturday evening after the food trucks and inflatables were gone, and cooling the tent for adults. Unfortunately, the race on Sunday was rained out, but we will try again next year. Those who had paid for registration in the race will have a chance to pick up a t-shirt and also have a discount on next year's race.

Next weekend will be our Annual Bishop's Appeal Pledge weekend. We will show the bishop's video for the appeal before Mass begins and we will have envelopes available in the pews for those who would like to pledge at Mass. This appeal raises funds for retired priest salaries, seminary tuition costs, the Marriage Tribunal, youth retreats, and a host of other good works. Please be as generous as you are able.

Renovation News: After many months of waiting, the light fixtures for the periphery of the church arrived and our electricians have been at work installing them. By the time you read this column, they should be in place. What I have seen so far looks beautiful. We have ordered more lights which will brighten the sanctuary, the altar, tabernacle, chair and ambo. I'm not sure how long those will take for those to arrive and be installed. The folks who installed the terrazzo flooring will be back in mid-October to eliminate the scratch marks in the main aisle and to smooth and polish a few areas.

One of our priests will be In Huntington this weekend and next weekend, covering Masses. Fr. Tony has gone to Rome for the diaconate ordination of two young men from our diocese who are studying in Rome.

I will be leaving for Germany on September 27 and returning October 7. I'm joining three priest friends and going to see the Passion Play in Oberammergau. A small village in Bavaria has been performing the Passion Play every ten years since 1634. It was canceled in 2020 because of the pandemic, so we are now rescheduled.

September 20




Volunteers Are Welcomed for the Vocation Crucifix


ST. CHARLES COUNCIL OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

The St. Charles Council of St. Vincent dePaul Society will meet on <u>Monday, September 19, 2022</u> at 7:00 p.m. in the <u>Hession Center, Room B.</u> Our organization does many different corporal works of mercy, such as feeding the hungry and clothing the naked. If this is something that is important to you, please plan to attend our next meeting to find out how you can lend a hand.

During the month of August, we were able to help 114 individuals consisting of 66 adults and 48 children. We provided \$ 4,144.90 in rent and motel stays, \$ 512.81 in utility payments, \$ 1,015.00 in cards for gas and food, \$ 1,280.50 for furniture and household items, and \$275.50 for food which provided 1450 pounds of food. In addition, we give \$ 200.00 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish to help an immigrant family for a total of \$ 7,708.71 to help the needy.






