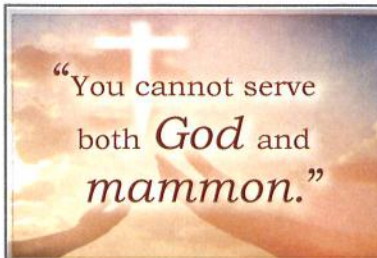

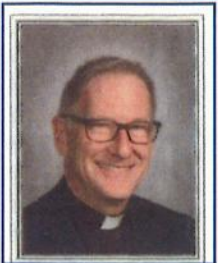

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

CATHOLIC APOLOGETIC STUDY

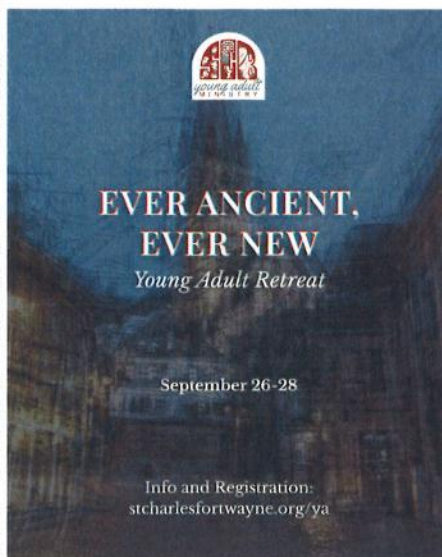

1. **What is the Annual Bishop's Appeal?** The Annual Bishop's Appeal is an important annual fund for the Diocese of Fort Wayne-South Bend. The donations received help fund various ministries, programs and services .

2. **What is the best way to give?** Giving online at diocesefwsb.org/aba is a more secure method and also saves processing time for parish and diocesan staff. You can also scan this QR code to give online. If giving online, please do not submit a pledge card, as this creates a duplicate pledge.



3. **What if I cannot give at this time?** Please still send in your pledge card marking it with a zero. A completed pledge card will save parish follow-up letters and telephone calls.

4. **How do I return my pledge card?** You can mail your pledge card in the return envelope provided, drop it in the offertory collection basket at Mass, or drop off at the parish office.

5. **How do I make payments on my pledge?** Monthly statements/reminders will be sent out by the Diocesan Business Office for 6 months. All checks should be made out to the "Annual Bishop's Appeal" and returned to the diocese in the return envelope provided, not to the parish.

6. **What if our parish reaches its goal?** Any money collected in excess of our goal will be returned to the Parish to use as needed.

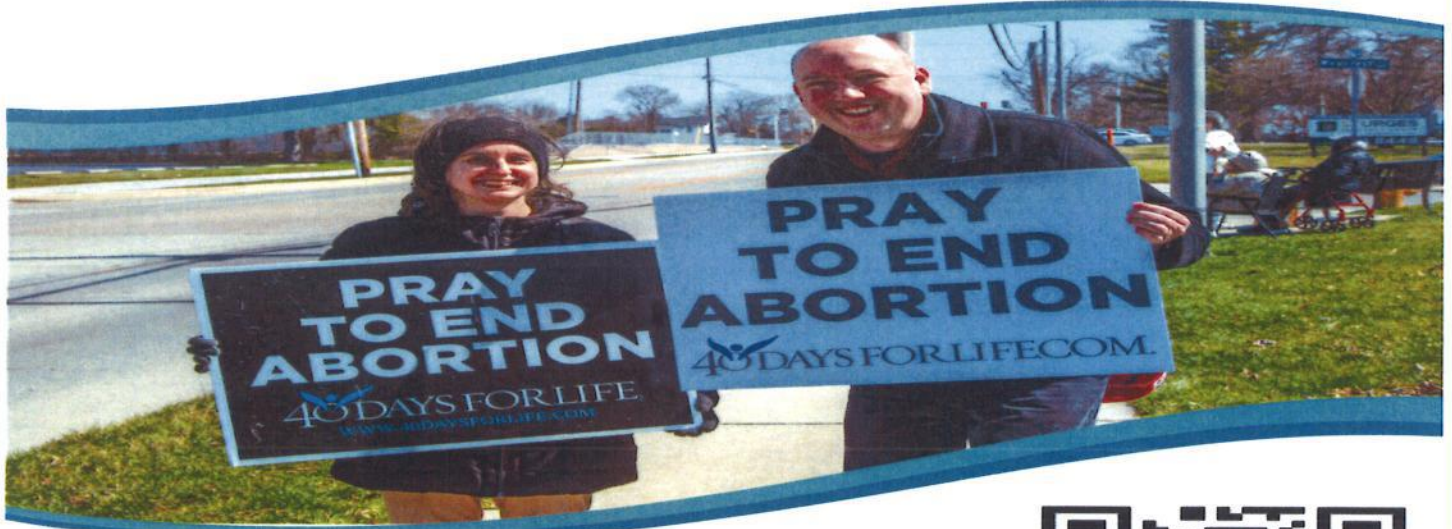
