

#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

During the height of the pandemic we had a great turnout for an outdoor event, projecting a Bishop Dwenger football game on a giant screen in our parking lot while people sat on folding chairs and ate food from food trucks. We are going to organize a similar event this Friday evening for the Bishop Dwenger/Bishop Luers football game.

Join us on our parking lot for food trucks and lawn games beginning at 5:30 p.m., Friday, September 30. The game begins at 7:00 p.m. Matt's Hitchin' Kitchen and Sno Biz are sending food trucks for those who are hungry. Please bring your own folding chair, dress for the weather, and please do not bring any alcohol. It will be a lot of fun to cheer with other parishioners for both of our Catholic teams.

Walking with Moms in Need is an effort through each parish to help young mothers before and after they give birth to a child. We are going to sponsor a Drive-Through Baby Shower on October 9, asking for baby formula, diapers, baby clothes, or other items which would be useful for a new mother. Bring the items to the main church door between 3:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on October 9, where volunteers will collect items. If that timing doesn't work, we will also have a box in the Gathering Space the weekend of the 8th and 9th to collect baby items.






