All Soul's day commemorates all of the faithful departed, and offers us the opportunity to aid the poor souls in purgatory by our prayers and devotions. In fact, an indulgence for the souls in purgatory is granted to the faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed.

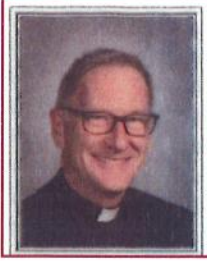

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This Saturday, November 1, is All Saints Day. Usually this is a Holy Day of Obligation. However, this is one of the Feasts which the US Bishops determined will have no obligation when the date falls on a Saturday or Monday. In any event, it is an important day in the life of the Church. We pause to reflect on all of the Saints in heaven and to ask for their

prayers. Our Masses for All Saints will be at 6:30 p.m. on Friday and 8:15 a.m. on Saturday.

All Soul's Day, November 2, falls this year on Sunday. It is the day when we remember all of our beloved dead and all of the souls in purgatory. Our parish Book of Remembrance will be in the sanctuary throughout the month of November. Please add the names of any loved ones who have died as the parish lifts them up in prayer. (We have used the same book for over ten years; there is no need to repeat names added in years past.)

Our Annual Parish Mass of Remembrance will be held at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, November 3. We will offer Mass in a darkened church and offer prayers for those who have died in the past year. We will read the names of each person who has had a St. Charles funeral since last November and light a candle for each. If you have a loved one who died in the past year and the funeral was not at St. Charles, please call the parish office and we will add those names also to our list.

You may have noticed a change in our church sound system in the past week or two. Our sound technician discovered that the amplifier for the main speaker was inadvertently turned down. He is setting a block on that control to prevent the same problem and he is making adjustments to the system. I hope that the sound level is better than it has been.

Just Neighbors is our local shelter for homeless families. St. Charles provides meals at the shelter three weeks each year. For the past 13 years, Margaret Digan and Maggie Kleber have led the effort to have parishioners sign up, prepare and deliver food. Margaret and Maggie would like to pull back and find new volunteers who could spearhead that effort for us. Call the Parish Office if you might be interested. This may be a good job for another duo.

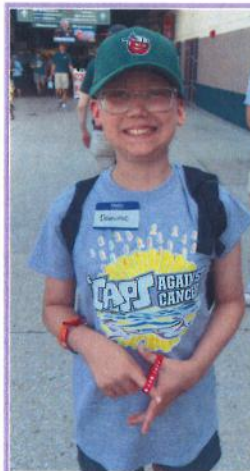


SIGN UP NOW TO TAKE HOME THE ST. CHARLES VOCATION CROSS Months of OCTOBER & NOVEMBER

Walk for Hope 2025 Summary St. Charles Conference of St. Vincent de Paul Society

Our amazing parishioners and 35 business sponsors raised \$ 40,000 to assist those in need right in our area with rent, utilities, food, clothing, furniture, gas, and the list goes on. Of the \$ 40,000 raised, over \$ 10,000 was targeted to sponsor Father Tom who once again was the top individual fundraiser for our Walk for Hope 2025. The data is still out at this point, but our SVdP District Director, Lara Schreck, believes that the \$ 114,000 raised at the Ft Wayne Walk for Hope, 2025 representing all 23 SVdP conferences in our area, was the top fundraiser in the nation for this walk (like last year).

Fr. Tom and our generous parishioners provide about half of the funds distributed throughout the year and this very successful Walk for Hope, 2025 addressed much of the remaining deficit. We wanted to provide this summary for you and our 35 business sponsors. You are amazing and you have our heartfelt thanks for changing the lives of so many people in need.

They will be happy to schedule a time for the pickup. Your generosity will be beneficial to the SVdP Thrift Store and the poor. The profits from selling those items will be returned to the parish SVdP Conferences so we can help more needy people.

During **September, 2025** we were able to help 280 individuals consisting of 199 adults and 81 children. Summary of assistances provided to our Neighbors includes bus passes \$131, auto payment \$355, auto repair \$254, food vouchers \$503, providing 1300 pounds of food, gift cards \$550, general assistance \$310, medical \$144, motel stays \$1,350, general household \$50, mortgage \$350, rent \$3,316, store voucher \$253, utility payments \$4,533, clothing vouchers \$20, partnering with local Parishes \$1,435, and \$200 monthly to St. Patrick's Parish. SVdP St Charles spent \$13,754 to help the needy in the community.

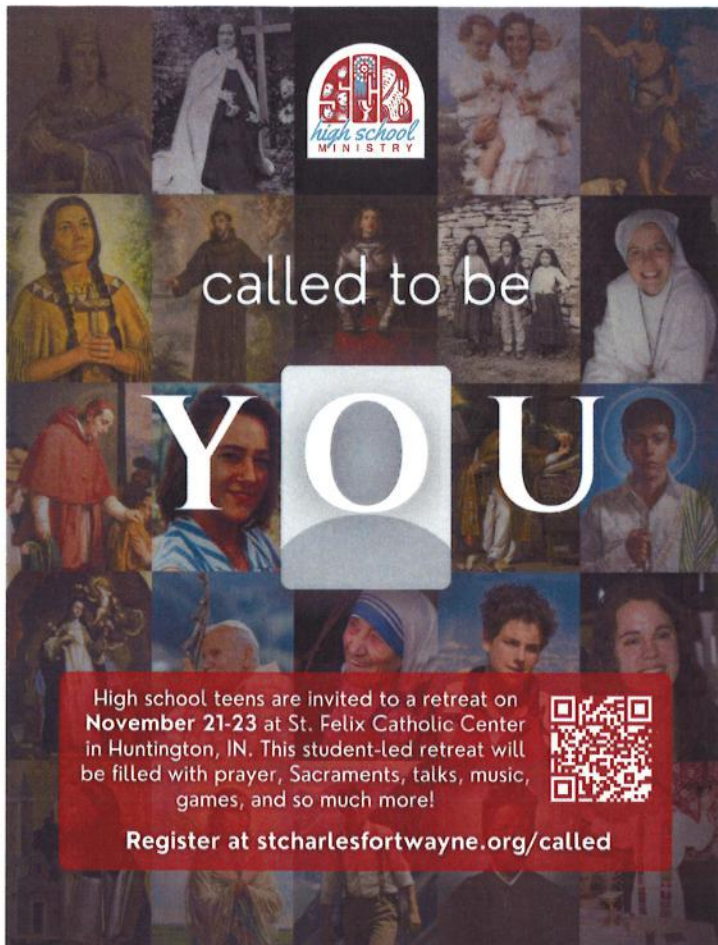

**CPR/AED TRAINING CLASSES**

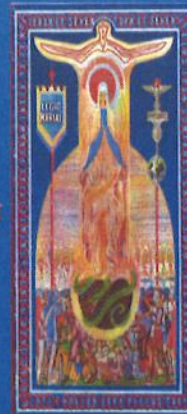
