
A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend, we are celebrating the Feast of St. Charles Borromeo. St. Charles was a remarkable Church leader in the mid-1500's, at a time when the Church needed remarkable leaders. He is remembered especially for promoting seminary education for priests, for making sure that clerics were serving their people as shepherds, and for pushing the Church to respond to the critiques of

the Protestant reformers by finishing the work of the Council of Trent. We ask for the prayers of St. Charles for our Parish and for the Church today.

We don't often have sales in church, but we have two worthy sales events coming up for those who would like to help with good causes. Next weekend, our parish Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts will be selling popcorn after Masses, raising funds to help with their scouting activities. The following weekend we will have Olivewood Religious goods for sale, an effort to help the Christian families in Bethlehem who earn their living by carving and selling religious goods. With the violence in the Holy Land today, this is a chance to help families who have lost their trade with pilgrims.

Mark your calendars for an inspiring event on November 16. Caleb and Natali Perkins are a young couple in our parish who became Catholic through our parish RCIA program on Easter of 2021. In August, Caleb was chosen to tell his conversion story in front of Pope Francis and roughly a million young people at World Youth Day in Portugal. After he spoke, he and Natali had a brief conversation with the Pope. Since becoming Catholic, Caleb and Natali have joined with Gloria Kohrman in organizing a group called Shema Culture, which leads praise music and has been instrumental in organizing ecumenical prayer events in Fort Wayne. On November 16, at 7:15 p.m. in the Church, Caleb will share with us his conversion story, along with praise music from Shema Culture. Come and be inspired by three young adults who are on fire with their love of the Lord and their Catholic faith.




SIGN UP NOW TO TAKE HOME THE ST. CHARLES VOCATION CROSS **Months of OCTOBER & NOVEMBER**
