

#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Bishop Rhoades came for dinner before our parish Confirmation on November 1, and spoke a bit about his experience with the Synod in Rome. He described the participants sitting at round tables, each taking a turn to speak about issues in the Church while the rest of the table listened. There were no arguments or rebuttals or debates,

but simply a chance to hear the thoughts and experiences of others as they live their life in the Church. He will return to Rome next October for the conclusion of the Synod.

Please join us on Thursday evening for a time of praise music, adoration, and to hear the conversion story of our own Caleb Perkins. Caleb was chosen to give a witness talk this past August at World Youth Day in Portugal. He spoke in front of the Pope, an arena full of people, and TV crews from around the world. It should be a beautiful evening as he shares his story with us and Shema Culture leads us in prayer. We will be in the church at 7:15 p.m. on Thursday evening.

Next weekend, Olivewood Religious Goods will be on sale in the Gathering Space after all Masses. A group called Land of Peace sells religious items which are carved by Christian families in Bethlehem. As we read of the terrible suffering taking place in the Holy Land, this is a small way that we can offer some support to the Christian community there.

A new group for young moms will have its initial meeting next Sunday, November 19, at 1:00 p.m. in the Community Room, with lunch provided. To RSVP for the event or to sign up for e-mail information, go to stcharlesfortwayne.org/friends-of-st-zelie. The first meeting will include social time, prayer time, and a celebrity speaker—the Pastor of St. Charles.

On November 21, we are invited to Temple Achduth Vesholom at 5200 Old Mill Road for an interfaith evening of Thanksgiving. A group from our parish took part last year, joined by folks from several Protestant churches as well as Jewish, Buddhist and Bahai traditions. It was a very interesting evening and a chance to learn about one another. Everyone is welcome.



Next weekend, November 18 and 19, Samer Awwad will be at all Masses, representing the Bethlehem Christian Families, a not-forprofit organization, to speak about the Christian situation in the Holy Land. The goal of this mission is to help Christian families in the Holy Land and Churches in the Middle East who have been affected by the continuous violence and the depletion of tourist to the area. Crucifixes, rosaries, and religious articles, all made of Olive Wood, which is native to the Holy Land and Bethlehem, are available to purchase. or more than 50 years, the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) has supported organizations that combat poverty and improve the lives of people in communities across the United States. 
An effective response to natural disasters begins with effective planning before disasters occur. In New Orleans and surrounding areas in southern Louisiana, CCHD is helping Together New Orleans develop a project called Community Lighthouse, which will equip 85 congregations and community organizations with commercial-scale solar power and backup battery storage. This effort will form a network of response centers ready to serve

communities in a hurricane or other natural disaster once the solar power equipment is completely installed. By using solar power and backup batteries, the response centers can continue operating in the event of power loss—but they will also be using clean, renewable energy rather than fossil fuels that contribute to climate change and pollution.

When you support CCHD, you help local communities across the country innovate and work together to solve their own unique challenges. Twenty-five percent of your contribution stays in your diocese to support the organizations addressing your community's needs for housing, jobs, and educational opportunities—and for keeping the lights on during a storm.
