

#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR


Advent begins next weekend. With Christmas Eve falling on a Sunday this year, we have a very short three-week span to prepare our lives to welcome the Savior. I think that all of us need a plan for prayer and for charity during this sacred time. Our Advent Giving Tree is now set up in the Gathering Space, a chance to help St. Patrick's

Food Pantry, our parish St. Vincent de Paul Society, *Walking with Moms in Need*, and our parish Pro-Life committee. For those who would like ideas for a deeper prayer life, I offer a reminder that we have three Masses every weekday at St. Charles: 6:15 a.m., 8:15 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. We also have many opportunities for confessions: Monday through Saturday 7:30 a.m.-8:00 a.m., Thursdays 7:00 p.m., and Saturdays 2:30 p.m.-4:30 p.m. We will offer a Parish Penance Service the evening of Dec. 13, and we will post the schedule of Penance Services held in neighboring parishes as they come closer.

On the evening of December 7, I will offer a presentation on the recent Redeemer Radio Holy Land Pilgrimage and our quick exit after the outbreak of violence. The presentation will conclude with a Rosary, asking the Queen of Peace to pray for the people in that troubled land. Join us in the Hession Center at 7:30 p.m. on December 7. (Note: There will be a Vigil Mass for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception at 6:30 p.m. that evening. The presentation will follow that Mass.)

Please remember in your prayer Fr. Phil DeVolder, who died and was buried last week. Fr. Phil was never stationed at St. Charles, but he had a bone marrow transplant in 2018 and spent almost a year living in our rectory during his recovery. As time passed and he gained strength, he did help with our parish liturgies and became much beloved, especially by our daily Mass-goers. When he left us he moved to Huntington, where served the Victory Noll Sisters and the St. Anne's Community until his death. May the Lord reward him for his years of service to the Church.

Finally, I share some shocking news: a few weeks ago we received word that our parish would receive a bequest of \$9 million. We have now received half of that amount and we expect that the rest will arrive by this time next year. The donor, a long-time parishioner, wished for this gift to remain anonymous. I have met with the Parish Finance Council, the Parish Pastoral Council and the Parish Staff to begin discussion about developing a wise plan for these funds. We all agree on the need to tithe: we begin by giving 10% in charity. Beyond that, we are talking about endowments, building projects, and a strong outreach to the poor. As we approach these decisions, let us pray that God will help us to maintain humble and grateful hearts and that He will guide us in the wisdom we need to use these funds to build up His kingdom.


### Sign-up book is located in the Gathering Space.


