We have begun the season of Advent. Unlike the world around us, we are not decorated yet for Christmas. We begin Mass in a darkened Church with purple colors, the Gloria missing, and a subdued tone. We are waiting. We need the time to wait in the dark if we are truly going to appreciate what is to come.

Advent is a perfect time for Reconciliation or Confessions. As we are trying to prepare our hearts and our world to greet Jesus, what better way could we prepare? We have a lot of options for Confessions here at St. Charles. Monday through Saturday, a priest hears Confessions from 7:30 a.m.-8:00 a.m. in one of the Reconciliation Rooms in the Chapel (behind the Church Altar). On Thursday evenings, we have Confessions from 7:00 p.m. until the last person is finished, and on Saturday afternoons from 2:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. In addition, we will have a Parish Penance Service at 7:00 p.m. on December 14, and we will post the dates of Penance Services in our neighboring parishes.

We welcome Bishop Rhoades to St. Charles on Saturday morning, December 3, for the Sacrament of Confirmation. We are honored to welcome the Bishop as the gifts of the Holy Spirit are poured out on our teenagers, that they may live a more vibrant faith.







Through Walking with Mom's in Need (WWMIN) our parish can help vulnerable women find support in welcoming and caring for their children. The WWMIN help hotline is


