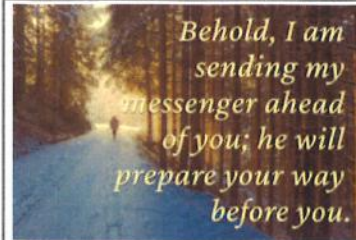

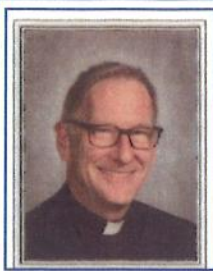

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

First, an apology for the cover of last weekend's bulletin. Bishop Rhoades will be here this weekend for Confirmation. Last weekend our bulletin listed the teens to be Confirmed. Unfortunately, we made a mistake and listed the names from last year's Confirmation. Oops. The list on the front of this bulletin is correct. We join in prayer for our young people as they receive this beautiful sacrament.

Today is called "Gaudete Sunday," derived from the Latin word for *Rejoice*. We are over half way through Advent. We need to be sure that we are prepared for Christmas. If you haven't yet made an Advent confession, there are many opportunities this week. Our parish penance service will be Wednesday evening, 12/17 at 7:00 p.m. Six priests will be here to hear confessions. If Tuesday evening works better in your schedule, both St. Jude and St. John New Haven have penance services on Tuesday. (St. John at 6:30 p.m., St. Jude at 7:00 p.m. We also have our regular confession times: Monday through Saturday, 7:30-8:00 a.m.; Thursday evening beginning at 7:00 p.m.; Saturday 2:30 p.m.-4:30 p.m.

With large numbers of people coming for confessions before Christmas, we priests are spending hours in our own parishes, but also helping elsewhere. In addition to St. Charles, I'll be hearing confessions this week at St. Joseph, St. Jude, St. Vincent, St. John, New Haven, and St. Joseph in LaGrange. We are grateful for the priests who have helped us at St. Charles with our many school confessions.

For the past few years, we have given away a book on Christmas, a Christmas gift from the parish. This year, we are distributing a book early because the book is about the meaning of Christmas. I think that many people will enjoy reading it in the coming days leading to Christmas. We ordered plenty of these books. Help yourself to a book, and feel free to give a book to someone if you think that they would read it.

I offer thanks to all who have contributed to our Advent Giving Tree collections. This is one generous parish. We have huge piles of donated items.

I offer a reminder of our Christmas schedule. Masses on Christmas Eve are 4:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.; our Midnight Mass is at midnight; and our morning Masses are 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Please invite friends and relatives. We always have an overflow crowd at the 4:00 p.m. Mass, but there is plenty of space at the other Masses. Our goal is to have an overflow at every Mass. If you are looking for our most solemn liturgy, consider the Midnight Mass. It will be a concelebrated Mass which begins in a dark church with the singing of the Christmas proclamation and lighting of candles throughout the church.

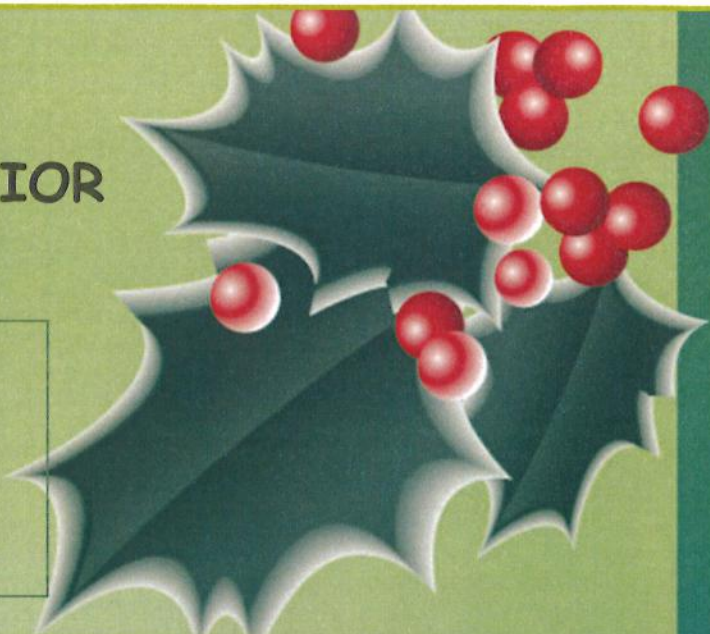

LETTER FROM BISHOP KEVIN C. RHOADES

For Catholic Charities' Christmas Envelope Collection

[An excerpt from Catholic Charities' 2025 Impact Report]

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Hope in the Lord! Hold firm, take heart and hope in the Lord!" These words of Psalm 27 resound in our hearts since Pope Francis chose hope as the theme for this Jubilee Year 2025. He wanted the whole Church and each one of us to be renewed in hope, our hope in God, at a time when there is increasing hopelessness in the world. As Christians, the ultimate reason for our hope is Jesus our Savior, His death and resurrection, and His promise of eternal life.

The theological virtue of hope is intimately linked to the other two theological virtues: faith and love. These three virtues are the foundational virtues of the Christian life. Without faith in God, we would be without hope since our lives would lack ultimate meaning and purpose. Without love, our faith would not be a living faith and our hope would be futile since at the end of our lives we will be judged on love.

Hope, rooted in faith and witnessed through love, is central to the mission of Catholic Charities. As disciples of Jesus Christ, we are called "to be tangible signs of hope for those of our brothers and sisters who experience hardships of any kind" (Pope Francis). All the works of Catholic Charities are ordered to the loving service of our brothers and sisters in need. This loving service engenders hope in the lives of those who are struggling because of poverty, mental illness, and other human sufferings. Our pro-life services engender hope in the lives of pregnant mothers in need of support. Our loving service of migrants and refugees engenders hope in the lives of those who had to leave their homelands because of violence, persecution, or severe poverty.

I am proud of the work of our Catholic Charities. Though we help tens of thousands of needy people in our diocese each year, I wish we could help more. Because of the mental health crisis in our country, we have significantly increased our counseling services, but there are still so many whom we are not able to serve due to lack of sufficient funding to hire more counselors. I am deeply grateful to all our donors whose generosity allows us to grow these services.

May God bless you this Christmas and may our diocesan patron saints, the Blessed Virgin Mary and Saint Matthew, intercede for you!
