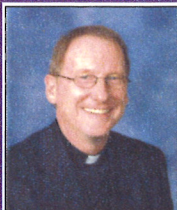

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

We encourage everyone to invite relatives, neighbors and friends for our celebration of Christmas. We would love to have an overfilled church for all Masses and we would love to have those who don't often attend a church join us.

A parishioner told me last week with some excitement that her adult son is coming to Christmas Mass with her. She had told him that joining her for Mass would be the best Christmas gift he could give her. I encourage anyone with adult children who aren't very regular in coming to Mass to pass along the same words. Our families are at their best when we come to worship together.

A little explanation about the schedule for next weekend: with the unusual situation of a Saturday Christmas, we will offer our regularly-scheduled 5:00 p.m. Saturday Mass on December 25. This Mass will be the Mass of Christmas—the same prayers and readings as Christmas morning. For those who have to work on Christmas Eve and Christmas morning, this Mass will be a good option for a Christmas Mass. For those who have already attended a Christmas Mass on Christmas Eve or Christmas morning, since this Mass takes place on Saturday evening, it will count for the Sunday weekend obligation. The Mass will count for either the Christmas obligation or the Sunday obligation, but not both.

By the time this bulletin is in print, our pipe organ should be missing. Pipe organs don't tolerate dust, and we are removing the organ console and many of the pipes before the church renovation begins. We will celebrate Christmas without the organ this year, but with plenty of other musical instruments.

We are inviting people to join us after the 5:00 p.m. Sunday Mass next weekend (Dec. 26) as we strip our church in planning for the renovation. While our decorating committee is removing the Christmas decorations we will also need to store all hymnals, candles, chairs, kneelers, tables, statues, and anything else that is movable.

Starting on the Monday after Christmas, our church will be closed for renovations. While liturgical locations will be changing, our Mass schedule and confession schedule will not change. **Beginning on December 27, Saturday evening Masses, all Sunday Masses, and all school Masses will be held in the gym.** Come to the gym door (Hession Center Door #3) for those Masses. We will have the bleachers opened and we will have chairs set out on the gym floor. We will encourage those who can easily climb bleachers to be seated in the bleachers, keeping ample chairs available for the elderly and those who find bleachers difficult. The gym décor will be simple, but we will have an altar, tabernacle, and all of the liturgical needs available there. Of course, there are no kneelers in the gym and I think that kneeling in bleachers is pretty much impossible. These small hardships will make us all the more joyful when the renovation is done and we return to our church. During the renovation, **Confessions will be held in the church Gathering Space rooms**, just as they are now. We will place an altar and chairs in the Gathering Space and gather there for all daily Masses which do not include classes from school and also our Friday evening Holy Hours.

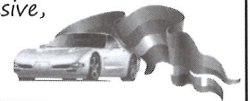
