

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR!

My biggest worry with the renovation project was the sound quality in church. While we have had a few hitches, I am hearing good reviews from the quality of our sound system. I'm especially happy to hear great reviews of the hearing loop. If you wear a hearing aid which has a T-coil button, push the button and you are tuned in directly to


our sound system. One person reported that his audiologist made a volume adjustment and he can now hear everything. Another reported that he had the T-coil added to his hearing aid. For those who don't have a hearing aid or don't have the T-coil, we have four hearing sets available to give this technology a try. Stop by the new sacristy before Mass and we will give you a little device with ear buds. We have people reporting that they hadn't heard the homily for years and now it is clear.

We are pleased to have Fr. Nathan Maskal now living with us in the rectory at St. Charles. Fr. Nathan is the pastor at St. John, New Haven, where they are tearing down an old rectory and building a new one. The new rectory should be ready in November, and we are happy to have Fr. Nathan with us until then.

Next weekend, we will have a speaker at the end of Mass who will give a brief invitation to Marriage Encounter Weekend. We have an upcoming weekend retreat scheduled for married couples on October 22 and 23, which will be held right here at St. Charles. This should be a great opportunity for couples to focus on their marriages.

Next weekend, Deacon Jake Schneider will preach at our 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses, his last opportunities before returning to Maryland for the last year of seminary.

We congratulate Fr. Bill Sullivan, who is celebrating his 50th Anniversary of Ordination this weekend. Fr. Bill served at St. Charles as a young priest and has helped us with Masses and confessions since his retirement from St. John, New Haven. As a seminarian, I spent the summer of 1989 with Fr. Bill and he has been a good mentor to me.



EUCHARISTIC REFLECTION FOR AUGUST THE HOLY SACRIFICE OF THE MASS.



Without supernatural grace, due to the original sin of Adam **Eucharistic** and Eve and our own sins, we are profoundly alienated from God. However, for love of each one of us, Christ freely

offered his life on the cross to restore us to Himself, that we may become children of God (Jn 1:12). On the cross, He is both the priest offering a sacrifice to the Father and the victim being offered. "The sacrifice of Christ and the sacrifice of the Eucharist are one single sacrifice: 'The victim is one and the same: the same now offers through the ministry of priests, who then offered himself on the cross; only the manner of offering is different.' 'In this divine sacrifice which is celebrated in the Mass, the same Christ who offered himself once in a bloody manner on the altar of the cross is contained and is offered in an unbloody manner" (Catechism of the Catholic Church. #1367).

In the mass, we are drawn into Jesus' perfect offering of love, so that we may offer ourselves together with Him to the Father. Furthermore, this great sacrament is also a participation in the worship offered in heaven, in and through Christ, by the angels and saints. 




