

### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

As part of our parish tithe, we are sending funds to a seminary in Fort Portal, Uganda. We received pictures last week along with copies of receipts, showing how every dollar was spent. The seminary classroom building is still under construction and now has glass in most of the windows and plaster over the walls. In addition, our donations paid for thermometers and sanitizer to help deal with the pandemic, and

huge quantities of beans and maize flour to feed the seminarians. They included this note:

"It has not been easy to run the seminary during this time of COVID-19, and it will not be easy even in some years to come. We are very grateful to you and to all the parishioners of St. Charles Borromeo Parish for having rescued us. Without your financial support, it would have been impossible to run the seminary. All the priests on the staff, the teaching and non-teaching staff, all students and their parents remember you in our prayers and we shall continue doing so. You occupy a special part in our hearts."

We are due to cycle in four new members on our Parish Council. The council meets monthly on a Wednesday evening to talk about the spiritual life, the evangelization, the social life and the direction of the parish. New members are chosen in a discernment session for a three-year term. (We pray over a basket of names and then draw out a name.) The Pope has declared this a year of St. Joseph. With the Feast Day of St. Joseph coming on March 19, we offer a simple novena prayer in this weekend's bulletin. A novena prayer is offered for nine consecutive days, asking for the prayers of St. Joseph. Those who begin this Sunday will conclude on March 22.

### "This Week in RCIA"

March 14 to the Easter Vigil
The elect and the candidates have
now entered the season of Lent. For
them, it is the period known as
Purification and Enlightenment. This

is a time marked with more intense spiritual preparation for the reception of the Sacraments. They will participate in different reflections and rites. It is a period for looking inward at self, turning away from sin and learning to trust in God's mercy. The elect participate in three rites known as the Scrutinies and the candidates participate in the Penitential Rite. The scrutinies are meant to uncover, and then heal all that is sinful in the hearts of the elect and strengthen all that is upright and good. Similarly, the Penitential Rite for the candidates gives them a chance to restrengthen their faith commitment that they have already made as baptized individuals. Please pray for our catechumens and candidates, Casey, Jacob, Graham, Brian, Todd, Natali, Caleb and Jessica as they continue their journey in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.


