#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

I am grateful to the seminarians and Karen Hope for all of their work in setting up our gym for Christmas Masses. We didn't know how many people to expect, but we found that the gym was needed for an overflow crowd at the 4:00 p.m. Mass on Christmas Eve, but not our other Masses. We had beautiful music and a beautiful place for Mass thanks to their work.

I am looking at the results of this year's Annual Bishop's Appeal, and I am very thankful for the generosity of our parish. While the diocese is trimming its budget and has cut our parish goal by 8%, our pledges dropped by only one percent. The result? Our pledges are \$69,000 over our goal. These funds will be returned to the parish, where we will put them to good use. To all who pledged, Thank you.

We received a beautiful note of thanks for all of the items donated to St. Patrick Food Pantry with our Advent Giving Tree. "As the need for food increases, it is more of a blessing for our Saint Patrick's Food Pantry and those we serve. Please give our thanks to your congregation for their generosity. We will keep them in our prayers."

A year ago, we had no idea how to livestream Masses from our parish and I wasn't convinced it was a good idea. Thanks to Bob Carroll's expertise, we are now livestreaming in a pretty professional manner, I would say. We typically have around 100 computers tuned in to our Sunday Mass, and with two livestreamed Christmas Masses, we had 252 computers tuned in. I am grateful that our parishioners are able to stay connected with this important ministry.

#### Pre-K4 & Kindergarten Registration Coming Soon! January 19, 2021!

January 19, 2021!
You are invited to our Kindergarten & Pre-Kindergarten registration day on Tuesday, January

19. Registration will be held in the afternoon from 1:15 p.m.-2:30 p.m. in Rooms C & D of the Hession Center, or you may attend the evening session from 6:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m. All parents are asked to park in the rear of the school in the church parking lot and enter through door # 3 near the gym. Wearing of a mask is required. If experiencing COVID symptoms, please call the school office (484-3392) to arrange for an alternate registration day.

**Kindergarten**: For this coming school year 2021-2022, we will be offering full-day Kindergarten with classroom size limits of 23 students per class with an aide assisting the teacher. Our school day runs from 7:50 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. If needed, for an additional fee, Beforecare and Aftercare service is available for all students.

Initial tuition costs are projected to be \$3,768 (\$314 per month over 12 months) for parishioners, and \$6,564 (\$547 per month over 12 months) for non-parishioners. The registration fee of \$50 is included in the overall tuition costs and is not a required payment at this time.

**Pre-Kindergarten four-year-old Program**: We will be offering two sections of five-day Pre-Kindergarten classes (A.M., P.M., or Full-day). Our morning program will run from 7:50 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. and our afternoon program will run from 11:50 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. The full-day program is 7:50 am - 3:00 pm.

Initial tuition costs are projected to be \$1,884 (\$157 per month over 12 months) per half-day, or \$3,768 (\$314 per month over 12 months) for the full-day program. A separate \$50 Pre-K registration fee is required.

Our January registration for our Kindergarten and Pre-K 4 Programs is early enough to ensure that parish families of St. Charles Borromeo have a first opportunity to register their children. Please bring to registration:

- 1. A copy of your child's birth certificate and baptismal certificate, even if baptized at St. Charles
- 2. A copy of your child's Social Security card
- 3. A copy of your child's immunization record
- 4. The \$50.00 nonrefundable registration fee

This is a very exciting time for our parents and young people. We want to ensure your child's school experience is a faith-filled, engaging, and supportive experience. I thank you for your time, and I look forward to having your child with us next year. 
