Also, from Council 451 representing the State were District Deputy Dr. Tom Ryan and Past Veteran's Affairs Chairman and PGK Steve Lutz.

A couple of highlights: The Delegates voted to increase the dues by \$1 while an additional \$3 increase was voted down. Next years Convention will be back in Fort Wayne at the Grand Wayne Center.
